Mandate: (i) Coordinate and guide the knowledge management activities of the Commission and the capacity development activities by various WGs; (ii) Compile the status of training and educational programmes offered in different regions; (iii) Compile the Educational Programs being offered in irrigation and drainage in different regions; (iv) Identify the training and education requirements, and identify gaps in available training programs, explore the feasibility of developing e-learning program and prepare guidelines for their development to support education and training programmes; (v) Explore the scope of use of IT in capacity development including distant learning, and implement where feasible; (vi) Make available various tools required for sustainable development; (vii) Oversee the establishment and functioning of a Technical Support Unit for supporting NCs; and (viii) Facilitate the process of balancing education and training requirements, and provision of training services.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 1: Action Taken Report by Chair

- 1. VPH Dr. Mohamed Wahba (Egypt), Chairman of the WG welcomed all the members and presented a report on the actions taken on the decisions made during last meeting of the WG held on 28 November 2021 at Morocco which are as follows:
 - (a) Preparation and sharing of TNA Report (ii)
 - (b) About 6100 members in AfYWP- Forum in LinkedIn
 - (c) About 45 Af-Countries in WhatsApp groups
 - (d) 3 Non-Af-Countries in WhatsApp groups
 - (e) Updating all groups with news updates, available reports, online activities, and opportunities
 - (f) Preparation of Online free course of VIA
 - (g) Preparation for 5th Af-YWP-Forum
 - (h) Preparation of webinar program

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 2: Review the mandate and membership of the WG

- 2. The WG reviewed the new nominations of the WG. Members such as (Ms.) Janaki Meegastenna (Sri Lanka) and Ir. Liu Xueying (China) attended the meeting of the group (physically / virtually) so their nominations have been accepted as provisional members of the group. The updated list of the members of the WG as **Annex-1**.
- 3. **WG-CDTE Mandate**: The members reviewed the mandate of the WG and observed that the WG is trying its best using IT for capacity building around topics of the mandate. China and India submitted the list of their training and education programme, which are now available in ICID website. It is encouraging that all the national committees and members are taking interest in submitting the information.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 3: Brief of the first virtual meeting organized on 28 November 2021

- 4. Chair provided a brief report of the 6th meeting of the WG held on 28th November 2021 at Morocco. The WG requested the members to share updated list of training institutes/ organizations & educational programmes offered in irrigation and drainage in their countries.
- 5. Er. Ashok Kumar Kharya (India) presented INCID proposal on organizing online meetings of training institutes in India. Such activities will encourage other institutes/countries to organize similar activities and also get listed on the website of ICID. Frame works can develop and shared to attract the member countries to ICID which may be helpful in promoting ICID based capacity building programs.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 4: Road Map to ICID Vision 2030 – Status of Activities of the group

- 6. The WG reviewed the Action Plan on the Road Map to ICID Vision 2030 based on the mandate and updating the activities on capacity development; training and education issues (refer **Annex 2**). During the meeting, the group requested the members to take initiative and identify themselves with particular topic(s) in the revised Action Plan of the group (2021-2024) for its implementation. The activities identified as per Road Map are as follows:
 - (i) E-discussion and Webinars at NC's levels, regional and global levels (Goal C; C5)
 - (ii) Analysis of the data collected Research Need Assessment (Goal E; E1)
 - (iii) Preparing programs for study tours to pilot farms upon request from NC's and others (Goal F; F1)
 - (iv) Support Capacity Development Activities of Member Countries (Goal F; F2)
 - (v) Technical Training of Young Professionals from Member countries (Goal F; F3)
- 7. Er. Harish K Varma, Executive Director informed that ICID has already organized a number of young professionals training programme and the last one was organized in Morocco (2021) and similar program is being organized at Adelaide (2022) in Australia. A study tour was organized on the request of Nigerian National committee to Morocco in March 2022. ICID has been facilitating such study tours and courses and other activities.
- 8. VPH Dr. Mohamed Wahba (Egypt) emphasized such trainings as these YPs are likely to be decision makers at National and International level in 10- 15 years' time. He further suggested to develop E-learning modules using the new technology such as Google earth engine etc. He also encouraged the Young Professionals to take up the research on challenging problems in the area of water and irrigation related activities.
- 9. Ir. Liu Xueying (China) was very excited working with the WG and informed that they will be happy to share their programs with the working group.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 5: Promoting capacity development, training and education

- 10. One of the important mandates of the WG is to promote capacity development, training and education in the member countries e.g. Short term training courses at WALMIs in India.
- 11. The Chair informed the members about the short-term training courses conducted by several Water & Land Management Institutes (WALMIs) in India. Er. Ashok Kharya and Dr. Rajendra Poddar from India agreed to initiate actions to bring all these Institutes under one umbrella to guide the capacity development activities in the country.
- 12. 'All India WALMIs MEET 2022' has been initiated by the National Water Academy (NWA), Pune, India on 22 February 2022. WALMI/IMTIs in the country have actively participated in the Meet and presented their position, working status, challenges and way forward.
- 13. Er. Ashok Kumar Kharya (India) informed that the NWA has been organizing these online presentations each WALMI is presenting the issues they are facing and their recommendations for the improvement. Already, 7 institutes have presented and 7 more to go. After completion of their presentations and discussion, the NWA will prepare the report and submit it to Government as well as WG-CDTE.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 6: Dissemination of Knowledge - Website

- 14. Dr. Wabha requested members to provide information, papers, presentation made on topics related to scope of work of the WG to the ICID Central Office for uploading on the website of the WG-CDTE.
- 15. All the members of WG were also requested to upload/update their profile. Only three members have uploaded their profile so far.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 7: E-learning programmes as a capacity development tool

- 16. ICID e-Learning platform is one of the initiatives to strengthen the capacity building activities. In order to achieve the objectives, ICID always encourages/ supports professionals from member NCs to join the e-Learning programs organized by various partners. The members may provide information on e-learning programs organized by them in their country.
- 17. Dr. Vijay K Labhsetwar, Vice Chair exhorted the members to share the information on elearning programme / webinars organized in their country, especially during the pandemic years. If members can share a short note on the subject along with some digital pictures, ICID will be more than happy to publish it in the monthly News Update or ICID News. It will be further uploaded in the ICID website. VPH Dr. Mohamed Wahba (Egypt) further promised that he will share and circulate this kind of information among thousands of ICID YPs in ICID Network throughout the world.
- 18. Mrs. Narges Zohrabi (Iran) emphasized the need of such E-learning courses under ICID. She also suggested to upload the information of E-learning courses in the ICID website.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 6: Webinar/Web-based seminar

- 19. The WG supported the suggestions of organizing webinars to promote sharing of vast experience available with ICID fraternity. The ICID CO requested members to provide suggestions on the topics, based on the mandate of the WG, on which webinar can be considered along with name of the relevant experts who could be contacted to develop webinars.
- 20. Vice Chair Dr. Vijay Labhsetwar (India) has taken the initiative and proposed to organize a Web-Panel-Discussion on "Capacity Building in agricultural water management is in 'Intensive Care Unit' Can it be rejuvenated?" The 'Concept note' along with the program is attached as **Annex 3**. The invited speakers are: (1) Mr. Russel Rollason (Australia), Executive Manager, ICE WaRM (2) Eng. Pradeep Purandare (India), Former Professor at WALMI (3) PH Prof. Em. dr. ir. Bart Schultz Bart Schultz (The Netherlands), Top Advisor at Rijkswaterstaat and taught Water and Land Development at IHE (4) VPH Dr. Mohamed Abd El Moneim Wahba, Chair, WG-CDTE. The panel discussion will be moderated by Vice Chair Dr. Vijay Labhsetwar (India).
- 21. As per Eol submitted by the WG, the discussion is to be held in April/May 2022 and the up proposal has been sent to ICID Central Office on 26 March 2022. The ICID Central Office is expected to set up a date for the Panel Discussion and disseminate the same. Under the given situation, the Chair suggested that it may be organized on 28th June alternate dates could be 27-28-29-30 June 2022.
- 22. Dr. Moshini Hafeez (Pakistan) informed that NC-Pakistan (ministries/agencies) organizes different webinars/seminars regularly and was keen to associate with ICID. Dr. Wabha informed that if the details of these webinar/seminars are made available to ICID, it will give these programs wide publicity through its network. Similarly, ICID programs should also be disseminated well within NC-Pakistan and its network.
- 23. Dr. Vijay K Labhsetwar, Vice Chair suggested that Pakistan can submit a summary report of programs in Pakistan along with 1-2 photographs to ICID Central Office for its due publicity in ICID News Update. Similarly, upcoming events on international nature in Pakistan could also be shared and disseminated through ICID News Update and other ICID channels.

WG-CDTE Minutes Item 7: Any other business

- 24. The WG supported the suggestions of organizing webinars to promote sharing of vast experience available with ICID fraternity. The ICID CO requested members to provide suggestions on the topics, based on the mandate of the WG, on which webinar can be considered along with name of the relevant experts who could be contacted to develop webinars.
- 25. The Chairman and Mr Varma informed the members on various upcoming ICID events upto 2025. Members are requested to check ICID website for details on these events and contribute as much as possible. It was emphasized that all these events will now be physically (face-to-face) held in their respective places.
- 26. Narges Zohrabi (Iran) Iran NC informed that they are ready to host at least one international webinar in English before Australia event (October 2022) on women empowerment and capacity development of women, water resources & irrigation management, may be at the end of July. She said they have sent the plan to Iran-NC and waiting for the approval.
