From Secretary General's Desk...

Dear Friends.

I was privileged to join the FAO's Regional Workshop on the "Analysis of Sustainable Water Resource Use" in the Asia Pacific region during the month of December in Bangkok, Thailand on invitation from FAO. A wonderful opportunity to meet our THAICID colleagues was also possible for me, utilising my trip to Thailand. THAICID and ASRWG were also represented in the FAO's Regional Workshop respectively through ICID Vice President Chaiwat Prechawit (Thailand) and Dr. Tai-Cheol Kim (Vice Chair of ASRWG). The latter made a presentation on possible collaboration areas between ICID-ASRWG and FAO-RAP while I made another introducing ICID and its significant contributions for the WWF5 coordinating a consortium of over 56 global water organisations. The workshop aimed to identify collectively define and identify issues relating to Sustainable Water Use. It came out that there were more preferences on knowledge pooling by improved information flows and creation of the 'Centres of Excellence' and 'Knowledge Networks and Partnerships'.

Representatives from the four Project partner countries who were involved in the FAO's Japanese aided programme - Vietnam, China, Malaysia and Thailand, several international organisations such as UN-ESCAP, ICID, GWP, IUCN, Stockholm Environment Institute (SEI), USAID, AusAID, Regional Groups like ICID- ASRWG, and national organizations such as THAICID, Institute of Technology of Cambodia (ITC), and CEDAC (Centre d'Etude et de Développement Agricole Cambodgien) were participating in the event. The aim was set as to collectively chalk out the project roadmap until its completion (funded by Japan). Each one of the countries projected certain case studies of their own; the dialogue processes adopted involving different stakeholders and investment framework and priorities while carrying out the project was explained to the audience.

The presentation on ASRWG by Prof. Kim highlighted what the Working Group targets, particularly on issues relating to Climate



Change. It brought out possible areas of cooperation with FAO, particularly while ICID addresses them in a few of the topics of forthcoming Congress(es) and annual conferences. ICID delegates pointed out that the synergising several and similar efforts will yield positive results in the ICID network countries in Asia.

Interaction with THAICID during my visit to Bangkok was extremely rewarding. I could call on the Director General at Royal Irrigation Department in his chamber who presented a publication brought out by the National Committee titled "History of Water Resources Development in Thailand". I was conducted around the impressive facilities that were utilized by the country for planning river basin management, holistically. Inter alia, this included the state-of-the-art flood forecast measures and actions that would ensure minimizing damages. I was also shown around "Greater Chau Priya Project" an impressive irrigation scheme that serves the agricultural and industrial needs of the rural communities in Northern Thailand. This glorious project has strengthened Thailand's food security enabling it as a food export country. I visited the Royal Development Study Centre, built around Chiang Mai. This was a wonderful experience. This planned development in the lines of IWRM advocacy, serves indeed as a model to emulate. It amply demons-trates as to how best holistic water resources management could be planned in areas that were once upon a time wastelands. I express my gratitude for the excellent arrangements that THAICID made during my visit to conduct around various facilities and meet with the higher authorities in Bangkok and Chiang Mai.

The other significant event of the month is my meeting with the distinguished Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Mali H.E. Mr. Aghatam AG Alhassane during his visit to Delhi. He was accompanied by Mr. Aliou Bamba, Technical Advisor of the Ministry of Agriculture who called on us in Central Office earlier. Very useful discussions were held on ICID's role in Africa and the upcoming African Regional Conference in Mali with the Hon'ble Minister. Elsewhere in the News Update, you will find a brief on this.

The New Year ahead has set before us a few committed actions to realize the enshrined objectives in respect of some key issues. which had figured in the discussion agenda in the last IEC. One relates to the 'Way forward on the Intensification of Irrigation and Drainage Research to achieve Global Food Security'. The other key item relates to 'Broadbasing of ICID membership' on which follow up actions will be taken up in Central Office. On the former first: I could have very useful discussions with Mr. Arjun Thapan, ADB on several issues in a meeting held on 13th this month. These inter-alia, covered our fresh efforts to invigorate the Intensification of Research and Development in Irrigation and Drainage Sector involving our NCs. Mr. Thapan informed us ADB's efforts to promote better water management in the region and the new initiative through Global Water Resources Group. Preliminary discussions were held on the scope for cooperation in the research and Development. ADB's enthusiasm to see our renewed efforts in promoting innovations in water savings succeed was apparent during our mutual exchanges. More discussions on these were agreed to for future.
